AB172 Teaching Labor History in Schools

School curriculum and textbooks traditionally incorporate corporate bias. This legislation requires the State Superintendent of Public Instruction to balance that bias by incorporating the history of organized labor and the collective bargaining process into the state's academic standards for teaching social studies. Learning about labor history allows students to be better prepared for the future as they enter Wisconsin's workforce. AB172 passed both houses and became effective on December 29, 2009 as Wisconsin Act 99.

SEIU WISCONSIN STATE COUNCIL SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION.

SB62 State Economic Recovery Bill

This legislation includes a provision that makes Wisconsin's tax system fairer to working families. It changed the formula used to calculate the corporate income tax to a system of "combined reporting" which closes a tax loophole that allowed multi-state corporations to transfer profits earned in Wisconsin to their subsidiaries in other states that have no corporate income tax. Prior to the passage of SB62, 60% of Wisconsin's corporations were paying zero income tax to support education, services and infrastructure from which they benefit. SB62 passed both houses and became effective on March 6, 2009 as Wisconsin Act 2.

SEIU WISCONSIN STATE COUNCIL SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION.

SB20 Equal Pay Enforcement Act

Under previous law, employees who experienced employment discrimination related to equal pay could only receive reinstatement, back pay or legal fees as compensation from their employers. This legislation allows employees who have experienced employment discrimination based on equal pay or other protected classes under Wisconsin's Fair Employment Law (age, creed, disability, race, sexual orientation, arrest or conviction record, national origin, ancestry, and membership in the national guard or military reserves) to seek compensatory and punitive damages in circuit court. SB20 passed both houses and became effective on July 1, 2009 as Wisconsin Act 20.

SEIU WISCONSIN STATE COUNCIL SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION.

AB75 Faculty & Academic Staff Labor Relations Act

The University of Wisconsin System Faculty and Academic Staff Labor Relations Act (FASLRA), a new subchapter of Wisconsin labor relations law, was included in the 2009-2011 Wisconsin State Biennial Budget Bill (AB75) which passed both houses and became effective on July 1, 2009 as Wisconsin Act 28. FASLRA authorizes faculty and academic staff in the University of Wisconsin System to join a union for the purposes of bargaining collectively with the UW System.

SEIU WISCONSIN STATE COUNCIL SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION.

SB523 Prohibit Public Funds for Union-Busting

This legislation prevents state government agencies including the University of Wisconsin System from using any funds to discourage employees from engaging in their rights to organize a union and exercise collective bargaining. Violations of these rights are considered unfair labor practices under the State Employment Labor Relations Act and the UW System Labor Relations Act. SB523 passed both houses and became effective on May 27, 2010 as Wisconsin Act 289.
